

To Our Patients and Families:

We hope this message finds you and your family in good health. The Board of County Commissioners allowed the public health order of Johnson County, which included requirements for social distancing in public spaces and the wearing of face masks to expire on Friday, April 30th at 11:59 PM. Although this order is expired, they are strongly recommending that masks are still worn indoors and social distancing is practiced.

Being a state-of-the-art dental facility, infection control has continuously been a top priority at LeBlanc and Associates. Our office has always strictly followed infection control recommendations and procedures made by the American Dental Association (ADA), the US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), and the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA).

- Expanding our appointment times to accommodate your busy schedules
